Recommendations

- National Roma Contact Points should engage more actively with key actors that are promoting or have the potential to promote Roma health integration
- Programme documents of **Regional OPs** should include activities related to Roma health integration
- Operational Programmes should use outcome and process indicators to demonstrate investments in Roma health integration
- The European Commission should monitor the implementation of activities related to Roma health integration funded by ESIF



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
